New game tests if you really are smarter than your ten year old

Mums and dads have been set a real life challenge: to see if they can do simple maths problems faster than their children.

A free online game called School Rules has been launched by Glasgow games development firm [T-Enterprise](http://www.t-enterprise.co.uk)

The game sets a series of apparently simple addition and subtraction questions against the clock.

And while the questions seem simple, it's not always adults who clock up the fastest times.

T-Enterprise's MD Sadia Chishti said: "Since we launched this last week we've been shocked to see that in general children score better results faster than adults.

"The questions are really simple but adults who are used to using a computer all day are having to wake up parts of their brain that went to sleep years ago. And their reflexes probably aren't as quick as kids who play lots of computer games."

Sadia and her team were inspired by the popular Sky TV show "Are you smarter than a ten year old?".

On top of their paid work creating games for clients and the Xbox 360, they build free online games to raise awareness of issues, as well as have some fun.

Recently T-Enterprise launched a fun Kung-fu shark game to highlight the problem of sharks being caught for shark-fin soup.

Another game spread awareness of the problems faced to the UK's bee population by the varroa mite, which latches onto bees and sucks their 'blood'".

T-Enterprise is a bespoke software and game development business based in Baillieston, Glasgow. It employs six people and works with businesses across the UK.
