## New viral game: Protect George Bush from shoe throwing journalist

A new viral game has been released where you play a secret service agent protecting George Bush from the shoe-throwing Iraqi journalist.

[Bush's Boot Camp](#) was put together and released by Glasgow games development company [T-Enterprise](#).

You play a gun-toting US secret service agent shooting shoes thrown at the President during his press conference.

Iraqi TV reporter Muntadar al-Zaidi was taken into custody after throwing his shoes at Bush [yesterday](#).

T-Enterprise's managing director Sadia Chishti said the secret service clearly needs more training.

She said: "If you watch the video clip the secret service don't move to protect the President until the second shoe has been thrown.

"We're hoping they will use this game as a training aid for future footwear attacks on world leaders."

In the game – which is free – you aim your gun at the shoes using your mouse, and click the mouse to fire.

You have to reload your gun now and then.

If a shoe hits Bush or you accidentally shoot him, his health meter goes down. When it runs out, you failed to protect the President and the game is over.
