UK computer game pits Bush against Congress in battle for the billions

US President George W Bush has an imaginary shoot out with the speaker of Congress to get his hands on the \$700 billion bail-out cash, in a new fun online game just released.

[Bush's Billions](#) has been created by Scottish games development firm [T-Enterprise](#).

Players control 'Dubya' hiding behind a patrol car after robbing a bank, and must fire guns at Speaker of the House Nancy Pelosi.

Bush comments on game progress during play, using real life audio clips of the President.

Congress is now the only thing standing between Bush and his rescue plan for the American economy. Earlier this week it turned down the first version of the plan.

T-Enterprise's MD Sadia Chishti said: "Everyone loves poking fun at politicians and George Bush is the easiest target in the world.

"So when we realised that the only thing standing between him and this bail-out plan is Congress once more, we had to put the game together as a piece of fun social comment."

The Bush's Billions game was put together by T-Enterprise's developers in just 24 hours.

The point of the game is to inflict more damage on Nancy Pelosi and her tank than she inflicts on you, as George Bush.

You use your mouse to aim and fire guns, and can duck when Nancy shoots back.

The game play was inspired by the film Heat, and imagines that Bush has robbed a bank for his billions.

Every week the firm releases games commenting on high profile news stories.

Recent games have attacked wannabe vice president Sarah Palin for her environmental policies, and helped sacked Lehman Brothers' workers steal stationary from the doomed firm.
