## **Kerry Katona is first victim of new virtual “ransom note” website**

People who want to wind up friends by kidnapping something they treasure and holding it to ransom, now have a fun way to send a genuine ransom note online.

Kerry Katona has become the first victim of new game [SendARansom.com](http://SendARansom.com) after her odd TV appearance this week.

The game’s developers have imagined This Morning hosts Philip Schofield and Fern Britton have kidnapped her “medication” and sent her a ransom note for £10,000.

It’s the latest fun idea from imaginative Glasgow games development company [T-Enterprise](http://T-Enterprise).

MD Sadia Chishti said: “Of course this is just a bit of fun, we obviously don’t endorse kidnap or ransoms in any way.

“But it is a good way to kill 10 minutes at work. You can steal your colleague’s stapler, hide it in a secret place and send them a ransom note demanding they make you a cup of tea before you give it back.”

[SendARansom.com](http://SendARansom.com) allows you to cut out letters from different newspapers, just as you would if you were making a ransom note in real life.

You have to apply glue to the paper, use tweezers to position the letters without leaving fingerprints, and then stick the letters down firmly.

Photos can be added and the whole ransom note can be emailed to a friend.

Sadia added: “Office life can be cruel sometimes and this is a great way to get your own back on the office joker.

“We’re looking forward to seeing the imaginative notes people can come up with.”

T-Enterprise employs six people and works with businesses across the UK.

In the last few months it has captured a clutch of headlines across the globe for its weekly games.
